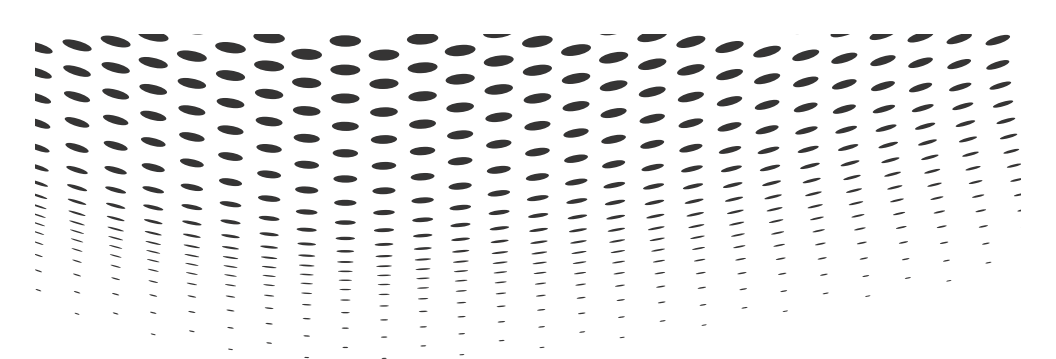

A. Get Rid of Everything that _____ You from
Following God - v. 1

*Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses,
let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us
run with patience the race that is set before us, (Hebrews 12:1)*

Greek Word: “Weight” (ὄγκος, ogkos)

This word refers to anything that is burdensome or hinders
forward movement.

B. Put Your _____ on Jesus - v. 2

*Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith; who for the joy that
was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is set down at
the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2)*

Greek Word: “Looking” (ἀφορῶντες, aphorōntes)

It means to fix your gaze or focus solely on something.

Greek Word: “Consider” (ἀναλογίζομαι, analogizomai)
This word means to reflect or think carefully.

Ye have not yet resisted unto blood, striving against sin. (Hebrews 12:4)
